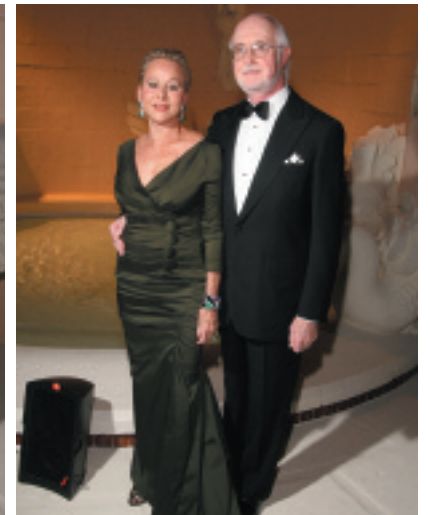

The Norton Museum of Art's annual Bals Des Arts was recently held at the Mar-a-Lago Club, Palm Beach. The elegant evening took place in the Grand Ballroom and included a poolside cocktail reception, a gourmet dinner and dancing to the City Lights Orchestra.

The event's theme of "Applaud The Arts" was inspired by the genius and innovation found in the current exhibition, A Show of Hands: Photographs and Sculpture from the Buhl Collection. Some of the greatest names in photography and contemporary art are among the more than 100 artists represented in the exhibition. A Show of Hands spans the history of photography, including images produced in the practice of science, journalism, and "art".
